Corten bench

The bench in Corten, designed by the Genoese architect Gianni Magnolia, is inspired by and takes its name from Varesè. "City of the Gardens". The space inside a vase that we would call "empty", becomes a generator of form. Support is obtained through the process of bending and welding of the corten sheet metal a "V" of the boxed letter to support the bench. The geometric decorations obtained with water technology jet and arranged along the seat and back, create particular effects of light and shadow that, from steel surface, are moved on the bottom. arese is the expression of the union of articulated forms and iridescent colors of the corten. The modular bench provides different composition options.
